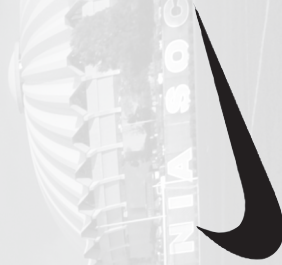

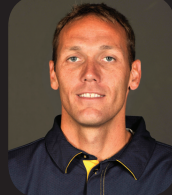

The West Virginia Soccer Academy staff will head a qualified group of experienced coaching staff from diverse backgrounds.

PHILOSOPHY

All Academies are under the direct supervision of the 2006 National Coach of the Year Marlon LeBlanc. Coach LeBlanc has traveled the world in order to study the "beautiful game." His travels have taken him to England, Brazil, EURO 2004 in Portugal and World Cup 2006 in Germany. It is our goal to teach, share and show the game through many different views as to better prepare our young players. We have created a challenging and competitive environment for serious players and teams. Our Academy will focus not only on the technical development of each player, but also challenge them to think through the tactical nuances of the game.

SUPERVISION & DISCIPLINE

Supervision is provided full-time by the staff from check-in to dismissal. Each participant is informed of the camp's rules, regulations and responsibilities. Each participant is liable and responsible for any damage to West Virginia University property. The WVU Soccer Academy for Boys will not tolerate any camper who disrupts the Academy, destroys property or does not conduct himself in a proper manner. If inappropriate behavior does occur, parents/guardians will be called and asked to come and pickup their child(ren). NO REFUNDS will be given to participants who leave camp voluntarily or are removed for disciplinary reasons. Parents are responsible for their child's actions.

FACILITIES

The Academy will be held at the multi-million dollar Caperton Indoor Facility. It features a 110x65 yard FieldTurf surface in a 75,000 square foot facility with state of the art lighting. The facility is equipped with locker room, restrooms and an athletic training room.

WHAT ARE THE ROOM & BOARD ACCOMMODATIONS?

Room and meals will be at the participants choice and expense. Morgantown has many hotel options available and very affordable prices. Transportation to and from the participants hotel and the indoor facility will be the participants responsibility.

DO I NEED TO BRING A LUNCH ON SATURDAY?

Each participant is responsible for their own meals.

WHERE DO I STAY?

Participants are responsible for their own accommodations, there are several hotels in Morgantown. Call or email Coach Brown for suggestions.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

Daily training gear, the surface is field turf. You can wear cleats or flats.

DOES EACH PARTICIPANT NEED TO HAVE MEDICAL INSURANCE?

Yes. Participants are required to have their own medical insurance. Each participant is required to provide proof of a physical within the last 12 months clearing them for participation in the Academy. This form must be presented by the time of arrival at the Academy. A parent consent form will be provided at arrival and must be filled out before you leave. A professional medical staff member will be on duty at all times during the Academy.

WHAT TIME IS ARRIVAL?

Check in for the Academy will begin at 1:30 p.m. for Groups 1-3 and at 4:15 p.m. for Groups 4-6 (30 minute prior to the first session).

WILL I NEED A SOCCER BALL?

Yes, you do need a soccer ball or you can purchase one for \$25.00.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I CANCEL MY RESERVATION?

There is a \$75 non-refundable reservation deposit for the College Prep Academy. NO REFUNDS will be given to participants who leave the Academy voluntarily or are removed for disciplinary reasons.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION TO CAMPUS FROM PITTSBURGH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT OR MORGANTOWN AIRPORT?
